Grant Guidelines for Researchers

Keep Punching is a 501c3 organization dedicated to supporting patients, health-care providers and researchers in their fight to prevent and eradicate brain cancer and minimize treatment-related side-effects that may adversely impact function and comfort.

Research grants will be disbursed as funds become available. Grant applications are welcome throughout the fiscal year and will be reviewed at the Board of Directors meeting closest to the date received. Total amount of money available for reward of worthy scientific investigations can be located on the Keep Punching website, in the newsletter, or can be obtained by email request.

Funding may not be used for food, alcohol, entertainment, furniture, computers, or other durable goods subject to depreciation outside of laboratory equipment.

To apply, please submit:

- A grant application cover sheet,
- The curriculum vitae of primary investigator(s),
- A description of the study requiring funding and how funds will be allocated to support overall aims, and
- A brief description of any past or present funding for the proposed project.

Primary investigators must submit bi-annual updates on project status to Keep Punching for review and auditing purposes. Funds not appropriately allocated will preclude additional renewal. Further, Keep Punching should be recognized in all publications that result from work supported by this organization's funds.
